



SCHOOL TUITION AND FEES 2025/2026 (in CZK)

The Academic year 2025/2026 runs from the 1st of September 2025 to the 30th of June 2026.

Placement at the **Perrott Hill British School • Prague** cannot be guaranteed until the required registration fee, tuition, and other school fees are fully paid. The parent/legal guardian is responsible for ensuring payments are made when due and informing the school promptly of any changes. Invoices are due within seven days, then the first reminder is sent with the same due date. In case of continuing non-payment, the final reminder is issued. If the payment is not deposited within the next seven days, the child/student will not be allowed to continue school attendance. No school documents, certificates, or reports will be issued unless all outstanding invoices are fully paid.

There is a **5% discount** for annual tuition payments (one installment for a full academic year, 10 months) and a **3% discount** for semester tuition payments (2 installments, 5 months each) under the condition that all payments are fully paid (please see the payment periods below); otherwise, the discount will be canceled. There is a **10% sibling discount** applicable for the youngest sibling, in case of three/more children/students registered, the middle child/children benefit from an **additional 5% sibling discount**. The school further offers a **special 5% discount** to children/students providing academic certificates with good results (e.g. Progression/Checkpoint/ IGCSE/AS-Level certificates) and a **special 5% discount** to students (Years 2 – 13) succeeding with excellent results in the entrance assessment.

Payments are based on the due date given in the registration agreement/invoices and are accepted in the CZK currency only paid by bank transfer (**Early Years and Primary School Bank Account No. 2309870257/5500, Raiffeisenbank, a. s., Secondary and High School Bank Account No. 2309950257/5500, Raiffeisenbank, a. s.**).
